1. **Organization:** Where in AAll documents 'organizations' are mentioned a systematically structured legal entity that pursues collective goals on a continuing basis is meant. Each organization will have a management structure that determines relationships between functions and positions, and subdivides and delegates roles, responsibilities, and authority to carry out defined tasks. Each organisation will provide legal documentation of its existence (such as business license, bylaws, etc.). Organisations must demonstrate performance consistent with AAll minimum standards according to the area in which they are working (AAA, AAT, &/or AAE...), and sign agreement of the AAll standards of practice.
